

AIRAANZ Early Career Researcher Conference Grants

AIRAANZ is pleased to be able to support up to 2 members who are Early Career Researchers to attend the annual conference. This grant is by application, and is intended to support those who have completed their PhD and are not in permanent paid work, or are in teaching intensive positions that do not support conference participation. This grant will cover the cost of early bird registration, and may contribute towards some travel and accommodation costs.

Applicants should:

- Be within 3 years of confirmation of their PhD.
- Be in non-permanent employment (eg sessional or fixed term contracts), and/or
- Be in a teaching intensive position that does not provide support for conference participation.
- Those students who have been examined, but not yet graduated may also apply.
- Have been an AIRAANZ member for a minimum of 2 years.
- Preference may be given to those who have submitted a refereed paper.
