

## **AIRAANZ Best Postgraduate Student Paper Award**

The Best Postgraduate Student Paper Award will be awarded to a current postgraduate research student, or one who has completed their studies within the 12 months prior to 1 July in the year preceding each AIRAANZ conference (the eligibility date). They will be required to submit an article on a topic relating to industrial/employment relations and/or work (broadly conceived) which has been accepted for publication in an academic journal in the 12 months preceding the eligibility date. Only one version of the paper may be submitted (for example, a candidate may not nominate a soft copy manuscript and resubmit the same manuscript once published in hard copy).

Nominations for the award must be submitted by 31 August. The Award will be determined by a judging panel nominated by the AIRAANZ Executive Committee, by 31 October, and the nominees will be notified as soon as possible after this date.

The awardee will receive AUD\$1000, which will come from AIRAANZ funds. They will be encouraged to attend the next AIRAANZ conference to receive their award and, if appropriate, to present their paper. Both the awardee and their principal supervisor will be offered a complementary registration to that conference.
